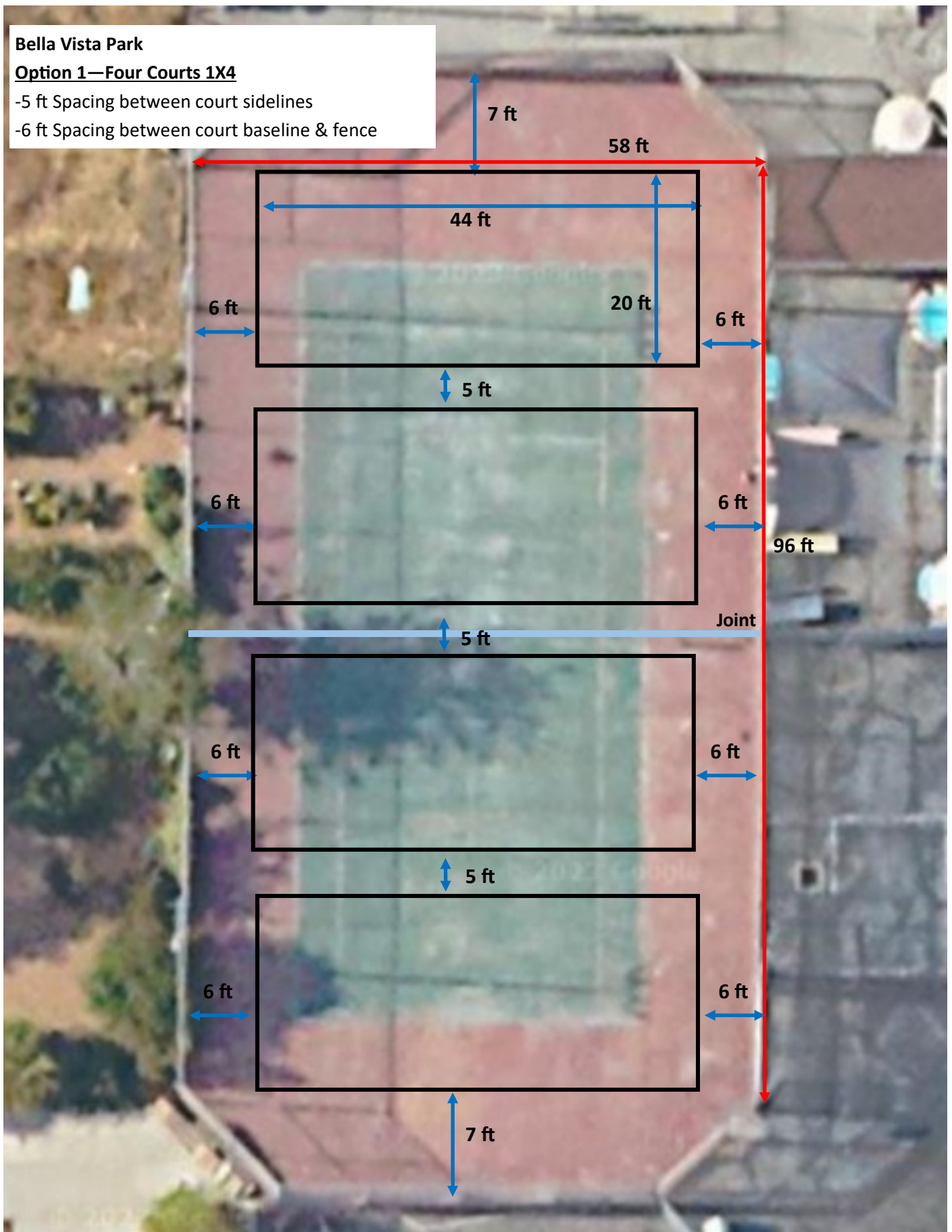

-6 ft Spacing between court baseline & fence

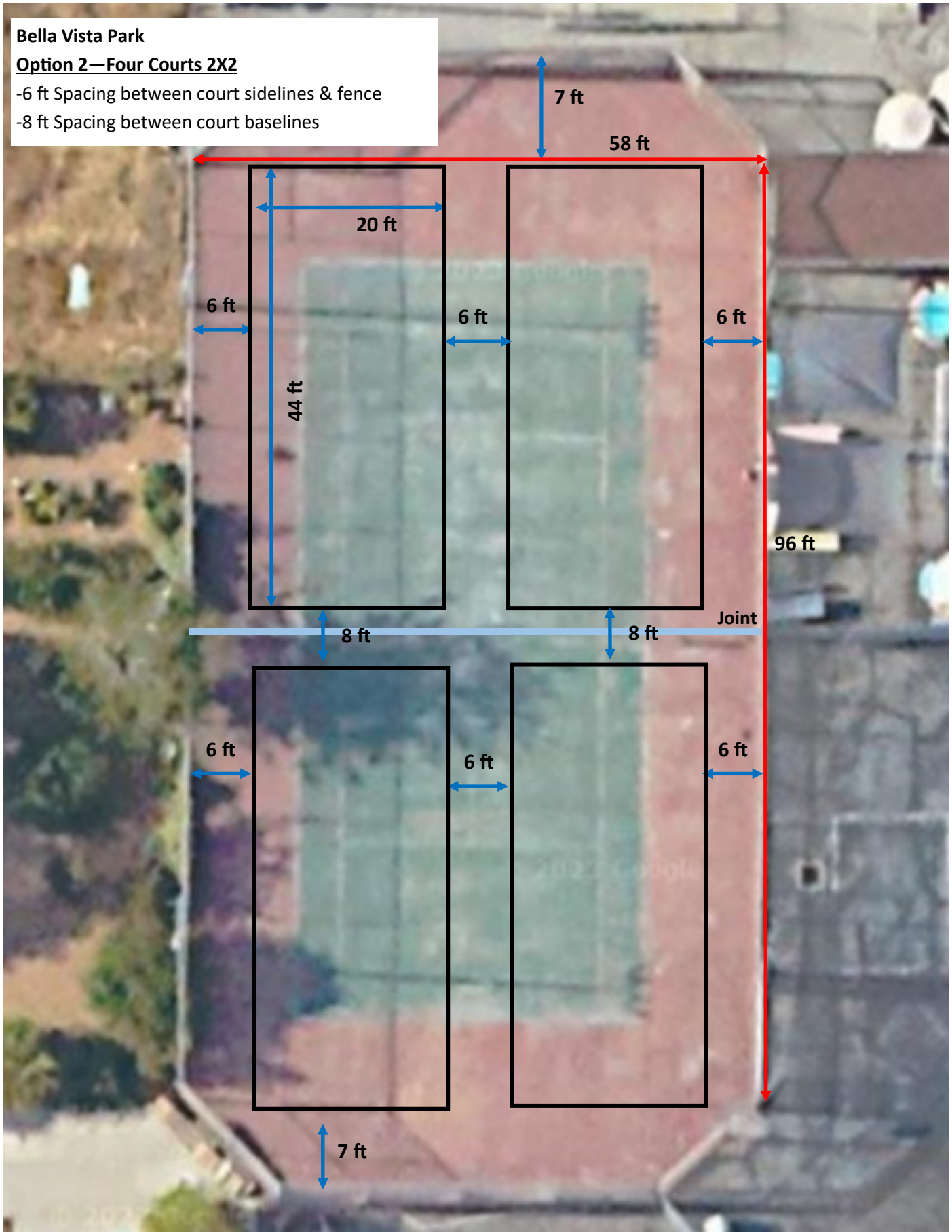


Bella Vista Park

-6 ft Spacing between court sidelines & fence

-8 ft Spacing between court baselines

Option 3—Three Courts & Drill Space

-6 ft Spacing between court baselines & fence

-30 ft spacing between courts
