

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R97

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS HELD NOVEMBER 5, 2024.

The City Council of the city of Monterey Park does resolve as follows:

SECTION 1: The City Council finds and declares as follows:

- A. A General Municipal Election was held in the City of Monterey Park on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, as required by law;
- B. Notice of the election was given in the manner provided by law;
- C. Pursuant to Elections Code § 10262(b), the City Clerk (as the City's Election Official) certified the results of the General Municipal Election as set forth in attached Exhibit "A," which is incorporated by reference.
- D. This Resolution is adopted in accordance with Elections Code § 10263.

SECTION 2: The whole number of ballots cast at the precincts, except vote-by-mail ballots and provisional ballots, was 5,049. The number of vote-by-mail ballots and provisional ballots cast in the City was 15,089, making a total of 20,138 ballots cast in the City.

- A. The whole number of ballots cast at the precincts, except vote-by-mail ballots and provisional ballots, was 1,030. The number of vote-by-mail ballots and provisional ballots cast in the City was 3,777, making a total of 4,807 ballots cast in District No. 2.
- B. The whole number of ballots cast at the precincts, except vote-by-mail ballots and provisional ballots, was 1,146. The number of vote-by-mail ballots and provisional ballots cast in the City was 3,266, making a total of 4,412 ballots cast in District No. 3.
- C. The whole number of ballots cast at the precincts, except vote-by-mail ballots and provisional ballots, was 822. The number of vote-by-mail ballots and provisional ballots cast in the City was 2,180, making a total of 3,002 ballots cast in District No. 4.

SECTION 3: The names of persons voted for at the election for Members of the City Council are as follows:

SECTION 4: That the measure voted upon at the election are as follows:

Measure BE: Shall an ordinance, without increasing taxes on residents, updating/simplifying City of Monterey Park’s 35-year-old business license tax rates, ensuring fairness to all businesses and helping fund general city services, including keeping public/business areas safe/clean; preventing crime/thefts; strengthening the local economy; by revising the tax rate to 0.00075 per \$1,000 of gross receipts (\$75 yearly minimum tax), generating approximately \$1,200,000 annually until ended by voters, requiring spending disclosure, funds locally controlled, be adopted?

Measure LG: Shall the ordinance providing funding for City of Monterey Park’s general services such as maintaining 911 emergency response and fire protection; increasing neighborhood police patrols; maintaining parks; supporting youth, afterschool, and senior programs; repairing streets and potholes; by increasing the City of Monterey Park’s transient occupancy tax, paid only by hotel/motel and short-term rental guests, from 12% to 13%, providing approximately \$500,000 annually until ended by voters; requiring spending disclosure, funds locally controlled, be adopted?

SECTION 5: In accordance with Election Code § 10262(b), the City Clerk certified the results to the City Council. The number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons named above for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates and the ballot measure are as listed in attached Exhibit “A.”

SECTION 6: The City Council declares and determines that Elizabeth Yang was elected as Member of the City Council, District No. 2, for the full term of four years; Jose Sanchez was elected as Member of the City Council, District No. 3, for the full term of four years; Henry Lo was elected as Member of the City Council, District No. 4, for the full term of four years.

SECTION 7: Measure BE and Measure LG garnered the required majority vote required for adoption. Consequently, Measure BE (Ordinance No. 2254) and Measure LG (Ordinance No. 2255) are adopted.

SECTION 8: The City Clerk is directed to enter in the City's records a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) the whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) the names of the persons voted for; (3) the measure voted upon; (4) the number of votes given at each precinct to each person and the number of votes given for and against the measure; and (5) the total number of votes given to each person and the total number of votes given for or against the measures.


SECTION 9: The City Clerk will immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; the City Clerk will also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and will have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected will then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 10: This Resolution may be executed with electronic signatures in accordance with Government Code §16.5. Such electronic signatures will be treated in all respects as having the same effect as an original signature.

SECTION 11: The City Clerk will certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


SECTION 12: This Resolution will become effective immediately upon adoption.


